Old Business:

Update on Pat's initiative on Electric Vehicles.

On hold due to Covid, Pat will try to reconnect with her former councilman (Mayor Dave Badeaux) to see if there has been any progress toward siting an Electric Vehicle charging station in Brainerd.

Continued discussion of BLUE's candidates' environmental scorecard for the 2020 election cycle.

- Discussion to identify possible future BLUE events or actions.

We decided to file an application to man a table at the Arts in the Park event on Saturday October 10th in Gregory Park. Pat will submit the application and entry fee.

BLUE's partnership with LARA and BLAAS in hosting an Environmental Candidate's Forum is moving forward. It will be a virtual forum this year via ZOOM. It is tentatively scheduled for the evening of Wednesday October 21st. An email requesting questions from the public for candidates participating in the event will be circulated in the near future. Invitations will be sent to candidates for the CW county board, the SWCD board, and the state legislature in district 10.

New Business:

Discussion on whether to continue our monthly meetings in person or on-line.

We will continue meeting in person unless the Covid crisis escalates.

 Discussion on whether/when to hold an election of BLUE officers, and if is one required by the group's bylaws.

Pat checked and the bylaws require an election in October. Isaiah is not interested in a second term as cochair and Doug declined to throw his hat in the ring. If you would like to be considered or nominate someone for office, please submit your nomination before or at our September meeting.
